

# Kutztown University is committed to students' success

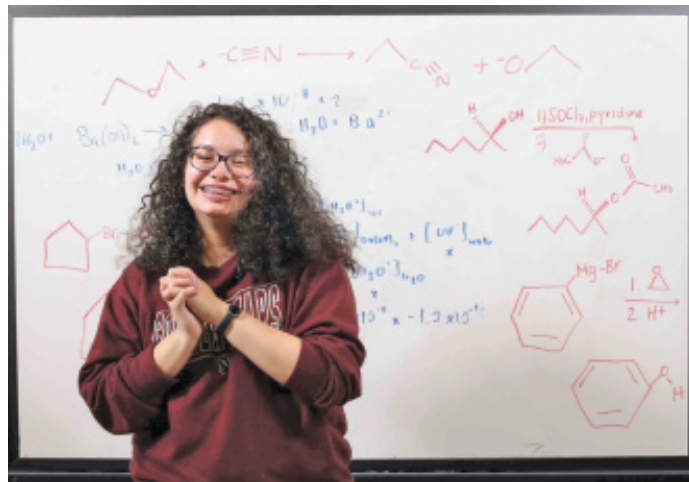
